- 1. Season tickets are non-transferable and remain the property of Guiseley AFC, hereinafter referred to as 'the Club'.
- 2. Season tickets are valid for all first teams' home league games. Season tickets are not valid for any cup home game or play-off matches.
- 3. Season tickets must be presented at the gate to gain entry. No season ticket no admission.
- 4. All season tickets applications must be accompanied by a completed application form, electronic signatures are acceptable.
- 5. All under 18s season tickets must be accompanied by a head and shoulders photograph of the child, this can taken at the point of collection.
- 6. Season tickets will be available for collection at all pre-season friendlies, home matches or by arrangement.
- 7. A postal service will incur an additional charge and the Club will not be responsible for the failed delivery of a season ticket.
- 8. Adult prices will be charged for those who do not qualify for any discount.
- 9. Acceptable photographic identification for the concession or age related rate include: current academic year student id, driving licence, passport, and proof of football team subscription.
- 10. You may be asked to present proof of eligibility for any discount at any point during the season; if you are unable to do so, the full price will be charged.
- 11. Reserved seating is available free of charge to all season tickets holders, subject to availability; the allocation of the seats is on a first-come basis. The Club retain the right to withdraw or amend the reserved seating arrangements; season ticket holders affected by such a decision will be informed, in advance, via email.
- 12. Any refund of season ticket monies will be pro-rata dependent upon the number of games played and those remaining.
- 13. Lost season tickets may be replaced at the discretion of the Club.
- 14. The Club reserves the right to withdraw a season ticket, potentially without a refund on the advice of the police or if a supporter is deemed by the Club to be behaving in an unreasonable manner. Unreasonable behaviour may include: excessive foul language, discriminatory language, violent or threatening behaviour, drunk or drunken behaviour, pitch invasion or any actions that may be deemed as bringing the Club into disrepute.
- 15. The revoking of a season ticket may also result in the supporter being refused admission to subsequent home games in that season.



Changes to the terms and conditions 2018/19



1. This season we are piloting a form of photo identification for all under 18 season ticket holders. All applications for these season tickets will have to have a head and shoulders shot of the young person. This can be provided by the applicant electronically or can be taken by a member of GAFC staff at the point of collection. If you have requested postal delivery of your season ticket any under 18 tickets will be held back as collect in person only. This is in order to prevent unauthorised transfer of a season ticket.

Optional Donations

- 1) Any donations made by any supporters will be ring-fenced into the project / area selected by them. The club will liaise with the official supporters' club committee members at regular points over the season to update on the current levels of donations and on how the club plans to invest the funds, whilst also providing updates in the match day programme and website.
- 2) Any donations related to "Build the budget" will be added to the playing budget for the 2018/19 season.
- 3) Donations towards pitch renovations and ground improvements will be discussed with both the groundsman and supporters club to ascertain where best to invest the money. Suggestions are welcomed if/when donating if there is a specific area you wish to see improved.
- 4) Donations towards our Academy will go towards improving the infrastructure and facilities for our young talent. This could also go towards funding an Under 21/23s team in the future.
- 5) Even if you do not wish to donate yourself, the club would like to hear from all supporters about any areas they wish to see improve and/or any ideas on how the club can achieve this.
